- *Your Bargaining Committee wishes to express our gratitude to the membership for standing solidly behind us with your strong 88% vote in favor of job action.*
- *Your frustration has been clearly communicated to the employer.*
- *We have agreed to 6 weeks of additional bargaining dates through the summer and into the fall.*
- *Over the last couple of weeks, the employer delivered letters to many individual members that state you have been deemed essential and must continue to work during a strike. We view the delivery of these letters as an intimidation tactic designed to undermine a successful strike vote.*
- *We stress that signing for these letters does not constitute your agreement, only that you have received the letter.*
- *Please look for a more complete progress update after we complete next week's bargaining on June 17th.*
